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Start with ½ cup boiling water and 1 teaspoon vinegar in a small container, then mix in the drops of McCormick® Food Color indicated below. Submerge hard-cooked eggs in the dye for about five minutes. Keep your hands clean by using a whisk as a vessel to add and remove eggs from the dye.
